

Death Announcement: Aug. 23, 1900
Telegram [Worcester] of; Caroline E.
Kendall. [Transcribed by: CJ Bagley]

Intelligence was received in Sterling this morning of the death in Providence,[RI] yesterday of Caroline E., wife of Oliver Kendall.

Mrs. Kendall has been known to Sterling people many years through her coming to the town summers to occupy their cottage on Kendall Hill.

She was daughter of Watson D. and Caroline B. Hatch of Providence, and married Mr. Kendall Oct. 18, 1865. Her health for some time has been delicate, owing in part to sorrow over the death of a twin son a few years ago, and on account of this ill health she has not remained long at a time at their Sterling cottage.

She and her son William came to Sterling in June and remained two weeks, since which time she had not been here.

Oliver Kendall, her husband is an artist, and is the author of the Kendall Memorial history. Besides her husband, she leaves three sons and one daughter. The sons are Oliver, William C. and Arthur R., all of Providence, and the daughter is Martha S., wife of Rev. Charles L. Place of Gardner.

The funeral is to be at their Providence home tomorrow afternoon at 2. George E. Kendall of Sterling expects to attend.
